African Century Agriculture was established in 2012 to provide a focussed platform for the production, procurement and logistical management of agricultural raw material commodities for stock feed – soya beans and maize. [African Century Foods has entered into a joint venture with Nutreco, a global leader in animal nutrition and aquaculture feed, for the production and sale of tilapia feed in Zambia, and distribution of feed across the region. The joint venture will construct southern Africa’s first dedicated fish feed mill in Zambia, in 2012, in a capacity of 25,000 tonnes per annum of extruded feed.](#)

In 2012, African Century Agriculture entered into a joint venture with Foradao Malonda to restore a 3,800 hectare farm in Niassa province, northern Mozambique. The farm, ACMatama, is located close to the town of Eichinga. In the first full year of operation (2013), 450 hectares were cultivated, all of it with soyabeans. The operation has gradually expanded, and there is now just over 1,000 hectares under cultivation, with a range of crops including soyabeans, maize, sugar beans and potatoes.
