Enel's 82.5 MW Paleisheuwel solar plant connected to the grid

he South African unit Enel Green Power, itself a subsidiary of Italian energy group Enel, reports that its 82.5 MW Paleisheuwel photovoltaic (PV) power plant has been connected to the grid.

Located in the Western Cape, the plant is Enel Green Power's largest power plant currently in operation in the country and is supported by a 20-year power purchase agreement with Eskom.

In addition, it is building the Nojoli (88 MW) and Gibson Bay (111 MW) wind farms and, in 2015, was awarded a further five wind projects with a combined capacity of 705 MW.

Once all the projects are completed, Enel says its total South African capacity will stand at around 1.2 GW.
