The company's goal is to become a large international independent producer of clean electricity.

The main activity is the development, financing, construction and operation of its own power plants operating on the basis of renewable energy sources (RES).

Elawan began its journey as a small Spanish company created in 2008. Today the company is part of the international production and energy holding ACEK - a European transnational company, a leader in the field of services for the production of metal structures, automotive components, and electricity based on renewable energy sources.



The parent company guarantees full financial creditworthiness and quality of production processes when implementing Elawan Energy projects.

Elavan Power, the Russian subsidiary of the Spanish company Elawan Energy, together with Wind Generating Company LLC, is implementing a project to build a wind farm with a total capacity of 72 MW and an investment volume of 7.8 billion rubles in the Temryuk district of the Krasnodar Territory. The wind farm, located on an area of 37 hectares, will be commissioned in 2021.

ASEC Holding has about 100 production

enterprises, has more than 40,000 employees, and is present in 23 countries. Elawan Energy, which implements projects in 13 countries (including Spain, the USA, Brazil, Mexico, Belgium, Poland, etc.), by the end of 2019, had commissioned renewable energy generation facilities with a total capacity of about 1.5 GW.
