Kibawe-Asian GreenEnergy Solar PV Park is a 12MW solar PV power project. It is located in Northern Mindanao, Philippines. **According to GlobalData, who tracks and profiles over 170,000 power plants worldwide, the project is currently active. Description

The project was developed by Asian Greenenergy and Vena Energy Solar(Thailand). The project is currently owned by Vena Energy Solar(Thailand) with a stake of 100%.

Kibawe-Asian GreenEnergy Solar PV Park is a ground-mounted solar project which is spread over an area of 18 hectares.

The project supplies enough clean energy to power 10,000 households, offsetting 7,499t of carbon dioxide emissions (CO2) a year.

Development status

The project got commissioned in March 2016.

Power purchase agreement

The power generated from the project is sold to First Bukidnon Electric Cooperative under a power purchase agreement for a period of 25 years from 2016. The contracted capacity is 10.5MW.
