

## **Lao Holding State Enterprise**

Lao Holding State Enterprise (*LHSE*) is a <u>state corporation</u> of <u>Laos</u> that is primarily involved with the financing of the <u>energy industry</u>, including the <u>Nam Theun 2 Power Company</u>, of whose stock it controls 25%. [1][2] LHSE is involved with other projects of Laos' energy <u>infrastructure</u>, including <u>Nam Ngum Dam</u>, <u>Nam Ngiep Dam</u> and the <u>Hongsa Lignite Power Plant</u>.[3] The company is part of the <u>Ministry of Finance</u>.[4]
