Project areas

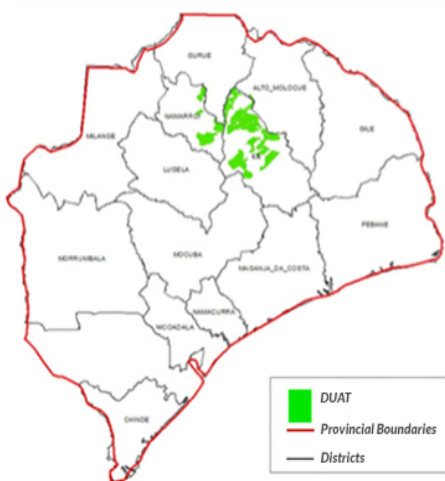
The Mozambican government granted Portucel Moçambique a land use permit for two areas, one in Zambézia province and a area in Manica province.

Zambézia

173 thousand hectares in Zambézia province

Zambezia is a province of Mozambique, located in the central coastal region. The provincial capital is Quelimane, 1600 km north of Mozambique's capital Maputo. Zambezia has an area of 103,127 km² and a population of 3,85 million (census 2007). It is divided into 22 districts and, since 2013, 6 municipalities: Alto Molócuè, Gurúè, Maganja da Costa, Mocuba e Quelimane.

In this province, Portucel Moçambique intends to develop its forestry project in DUAT plots located in Ile districts, Mulevala and Namarroi.



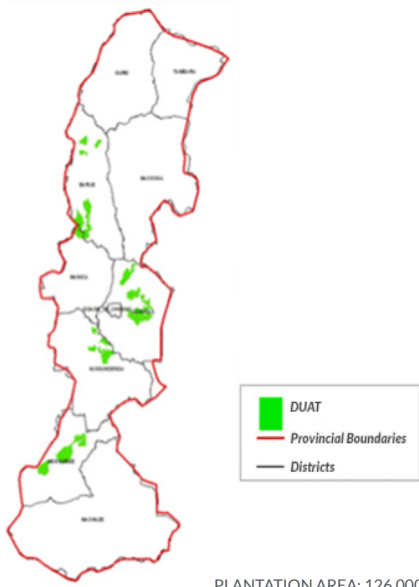

Manica

183 thousand hectares in Manica province

Manica is a province located in the central region of Mozambique. Provincial capital is Chimoio 1100 km north of Maputo, the country's capital, and 200km west of coastal city Beira. It has an area of 62,272 km² and a population of 1,412,245 (2007 census). It is divided into 12 districts and 5 municipalities: Catandica, Chimoio, Gondola, Manica e Sussundenga.

In this province, the DUAT Area Portucel Moçambique totals 183,000 hectares, being present in 5 districts: Bárue, Gondola, Manica, Mossurize and Sussendenga.
