"PYATCHKY" SURVIVED THE OCCUPATION AND ARE REVIVING themselves

Elegant shops with green and pink squares and a cheerful piglet have always evoked a feeling of something close and

personal. It smells delicious, friendly sellers who know the preferences of their visitors, always ask about life and offer "only fresh and only for you".

But now there is a war, so the buildings are in trouble. Perhaps it hurts them just as much when their pupils - windows are torn out by a shock wave, when the bare edges of the ceilings glow after powerful racist bombs. Buildings absorb blows, protect residents with walls and protect them in basements until the last. In any case, this is how it seems to us when we drive through the streets of dilapidated capital cities.

Small shops "Pyatachok" experienced the same. Some of them are looted, some with broken windows, some with a lot of holes in the body, but the most important thing is that all our sellers survived. One of the girls was taken by the Russians to Belarus and she managed to get to Poland from there on her own, someone is still in the west of Ukraine or moved to relatives. Some experienced all the charms of occupation by spending a month in the basement.



"It's a pity that Natalya and I don't have the opportunity to work in our "Pyatachka" in Gostomel, where the fighting is going on, but I really hope that very soon our troops will drive the occupiers from our land, our Natusya will be found and we will again we will work in our "Pyatachka", - this is what one of the saleswomen wrote under a post on Facebook on March 18 of this year.

And here Kyiv region has already been liberated and life is beginning to return to it.



"From the first days of deoccupation, TM "Pyatachok" began to work on the restoration of the network. A total of 3 of our stores came under occupation and one in the "line of fire". The facility in Rusanov was the least affected, there was no power supply there, so immediately after the release we managed to restore it and the next day it was already working. Currently, a full range of products and related goods is provided there.

One of the newly built stores in Gostomel. Here "Pyatachka" was frankly flattered, because it was not affected. Even the windows are not broken, but it looks very scary against the background of broken high-rise buildings, so we are waiting for the supply of electricity and the arrangement of the store. At the beginning of the hostilities, we gave all the goods to the local residents, possibly earning good karma for the store.

But the shops in Borodyanka and Makarov were looted, the attack there was so swift that they didn't even get their bearings. Makarivskyi - damaged, the windows were blown out by the blast wave. In Borodyanka, not only the windows were broken, but also the refrigerators were broken. Almost everywhere pieces of metal damaged the facades, but it's not scary, we will repair it. Builders are currently conducting inspections and starting repair work. We understand the difficult times experienced by the residents of the occupied cities, so we are trying to return life to normal as soon as possible. "Piatachok" is always close to its fans and is ready to give strength for the Victory," says Oleksandr Kucher, financial director of the company, curator of TM "Piatachok".
