


Penlok deadline June 6, Land in Wadas Village is measured again

Commitment Making Officer (PPK) for land acquisition for the Bener Dam, Serayu Opak River Region Center (BBWSSO), Herry Prasetyo, said that land measurements in Wadas Village for land acquisition purposes would be carried out over three days from April 11-13. "The total area in Wadas that must be acquired is 124 hectares, 93.7 hectares have been paid for. "The remainder, which is now starting to be measured, has a



total area of 33 hectares," he said Tuesday (11/4).

Namely, on plots of land whose owners have agreed to be measured. It was stated that the owners of the remaining land apparently still refused. In fact, the target location limit (penlok) ends on June 6 2023.

Meanwhile, Bener Dam Physical PPK, BBWSSO M. Yushar Yahya added, if after three days of measurements there are still those who do not agree with the consignment mechanism or deposit of compensation money in court, it will be carried out. His party, he said, had taken persuasive steps but there were still people who refused, so this had to be done. "Of course, the owner will suffer a huge loss, because the calculation of plant growth is not included," he continued.

He admitted that he had held discussions several times with residents who refused. However, it has not produced maximum results. One of them is due to the problem of land prices which are not yet appropriate. Residents want price negotiations up front before measuring. However, the procedure requires that the land be measured first.

Based on previous compensation, land in Wadas Village was valued at IDR 213 thousand to IDR 265 thousand per meter. The average price of compensation per meter can reach IDR 700 thousand, including planting. To seek residents' approval, his party has even offered several facilities to those who refuse. For example, drilling wells at up to five points and repairing roads. (han/pre)
