The project was developed by <u>Acwa Power</u>, Moroccan Agency for Sustainable Energy and UPC Renewables. The project is currently owned by <u>Acwa Power</u> with a stake of 51%.

The project generates 370GWh electricity thereby offsetting 144,000t of carbon dioxide emissions (CO2) a year.

The Tubular Steel towers installed at the project site are 80m high.

Development status

The project is currently active. The project got commissioned in June 2018.
