Scatec Solar and partners have grid connected and reached commercial operation for the 4 in Northwest Malaysia.

The solar power plant is expected to deliver 67 GWh of electricity an abatement of about 44,000 tonnes of CO2 emissions every year.

"As the leading independent power producer in Malaysia, we are pleased to reach this milestone for our fourth project in the country" said Raymond Carls. We expect that the government will maintain the same level of ambition in the power sector as before, and Malaysia continues to be a prioritised market for us.

The project has been realised in a consortium with Fumase (Malaysia) Sdn Bhd, a Singapore based asset management and development company focused on re



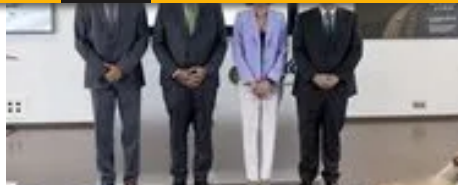
