December 2018	We are continuing our engagement efforts and getting further updates on the progress of the action plan.
January 2019	TH Plantations confirmed that the moratorium is still in effect and that they have carried out land rehabilitation for areas that were accidentally cleared. They are also looking for solutions to deal with logging concessions located in their area.
