



Agrotrade Group increased its land bank by more than 10 thousand hectares

The Agrotrade Group acquired three new agricultural enterprises as part of a development program that involves increasing the land bank to 100-150 thousand hectares, as well as concentrating land near its own elevators. Thus, the total land bank of Agrotrade today is 59 thousand hectares, the company's press service reported.

LLC "Ukrzernoprom-Shevchenkovo" is located in the village of Novonikolayevka, Shevchenkovsky district, Kharkov region. In the structure of the enterprise's crops, equal parts - 25% each - are winter wheat and corn. In addition, soybeans, barley, and sunflowers are grown here. In total, the enterprise cultivates 3,750 hectares.

JLLC "Zolochevskoe" also operates in the village. Zolochev, Kharkov region, specializes in growing corn, which occupies 59% of the area. Barley, soybeans and other crops occupy a small part in the crop structure.

The third enterprise – JLLC "Imeni Vatutin" – is located in the village. Khalimonovo, Bakhmach district, Chernigov region. Here, too, most of the area is occupied by winter wheat and corn - 30% each.

The production program adopted at the new enterprises involves the use of seed material of both spring and winter groups of Agrotrade's own production. All new enterprises are located in close proximity to the group's grain elevators and grain collection points. In particular, the distance from Ukrzernoprom-Shevchenkovo LLC and Vatutina JV LLC to their own granaries is only about 30 km.

The Agrotrade Group is a vertically integrated holding of a complete agroindustrial cycle, which is engaged in the production, processing, storage and trade of agricultural products. The group includes 15 agricultural enterprises, 12 elevators and grain receiving enterprises with a total storage capacity of 530 thousand tons in five regions of Ukraine. It manages about 59 thousand hectares of agricultural land in the Chernigov, Sumy, Poltava and Kharkov regions.
