

Villager's Land Dispute and PT Satria Hupasarana, Head of Lamandau Police: Different Perceptions

NANGA BULIK – The land dispute between ex-transmigration residents of Bukit Raya and Bukit Makmur Villages, Mentohi Raya District and PT Satria Hupasarana is still continuing. In fact, the initiative of the Lamandau Police Chief AKBP Arif Budi Purnomo was to mediate between the two parties.

"We support all legal channels that are carried out procedurally. We are not taking sides with one of our camps in a neutral position," emphasized AKBP Arif Budi Purnomo, Thursday 17 June 2021 yesterday.

From the results of communications made to both parties, AKBP Arif found differences in perception and interpretation between the disputing parties regarding the results of the decision in the cassation civil case of the Supreme Court of the Republic of Indonesia no: 2979K/Pdt/2013, Thursday 27 November 2014.

"So it needs to be straightened out, there must be an explanation from the Supreme Court which issued this decision, for the legal follow-up of the decision. If there is an execution order from the Supreme Court, I will immediately oversee the execution, there is no need for the public," said Arif.

For this reason, his party will urge the Lamandau District Court to coordinate with the Supreme Court regarding the explanation and follow-up of the Supreme Court decision. Later the Head of the District Court together with the Police Chief will accompany the company and the public to come directly to the Supreme Court.

"The process that has been taken using legal channels has gone well, it remains only to straighten out the differences in perceptions. So we will bridge. Don't let people do things that are against the law just because of differences in interpretation. The Supreme Court is the highest court, whatever orders and fatwas we will oversee and carry out," said Arif.

Meanwhile, representing the company, Mustari, when confirmed, did not wish to provide further explanation. He only said that the company would follow what had been decided together with the Police Chief and wait for the results of the true interpretation of the Supreme Court decision.

Apart from that, the people who demand the acceleration of the execution of the land also stated that they would respect the efforts made by the Head of Police. However, the public will still report this to the Central Government, either through the National Police Chief or the ATR/BPN Ministry. (Andre/ beritasampit.co.id).
