



Wind

Wind turbines use the kinetic energy of wind to generate electricity. It is one of the renewable energy sources with the lowest environmental impact.

EDC Burgos Wind Power Corporation (EBWPC), a subsidiary of EDC, is the owner and operator of the 150-MW Burgos Wind Project in Burgos, Ilocos Norte. The Philippines's largest wind power project, it occupies a 600-hectare site covering three barangays; namely Saoit, Poblacion, and Nagsurot, in Burgos, Ilocos Norte. The project consists of 50 large scale Vestas V90 3-MW wind turbines, and a 115-kV transmission line connecting the wind farm from Burgos substation to the Laoag substation, as well as the expansion of the switchyard/substations.

Since it has been issued a certificate of compliance from the Energy Regulatory Commission, it has been entitled to a Feed-in-Tarrif rate of PHP 8.53/kWh for a period of 20 years starting from November 11, 2014 to November 10, 2034.
