Buzwagi

Buzwagi commenced commercial production in 2009 and has produced over 900,000 ounces to date. The current life of mine is estimated to be 5 years with 3 years of mining and 2 years of processing stockpiles based on proven and probable gold reserves of 0.9 million ounces.

Overview



Buzwagi is a shear-hosted quartz-veined deposit, hosted in porphyritic granite. The mine is a low grade bulk deposit with a single large open pit.

The process plant is designed with a throughput capacity of 12,000 tonnes of ore per day (c. 4.4 million tonnes per year) and produces both doré and copper/gold concentrate.
