North Mara

North Mara commenced commercial production in 2002 and has produced over 2 million ounces to date. The current life of mine is estimated to be 9 years based on proven and probable gold reserves of 2 million ounces.

Overview



The North Mara gold deposits are situated in the Mara Musoma greenstone belt. There are several types of gold mineralisation including shear-zone-related quartz vein and disseminated gold.

North Mara is a high grade open pit mine consisting of three open pit deposits: Nyabirama, Gokona and Nyabigena. The mine is currently moving forward with the creation of an underground operation at the Gokona pit.

The North Mara process plant has the capacity to process an average of 8,000 tonnes of ore per day, (or c. 2.8 million tonnes per year) and produces both doré.
