ANIT Project

Project Summary:

- 100% owned new surficial uranium discovery in Rio Negro, Argentina
- Property located in a new uranium district that has seen little or no exploration to date

Discovery History:

The 2007 airborne radiometric survey over the Anit project identified a 15km long uranium anomaly locally up to 1.5km wide. The Company's technical team ground-truthed the anomaly and immediately located several rock samples with visible uranium mineralization along a freshly graded gravel road that cuts across a portion of the anomaly. The Anit project has had no prior exploration history and represents a brand new grassroots uranium discovery.

Location and Access:

The Anit Property lies to the south of, and is contiguous with, the Santa Barbara Property in the Province of Rio Negro, Argentina. The property has year-round access through a well-maintained gravel road, and is in a semi-arid area with low rainfall and population density.

Regional Geology:

Regional geologic maps show early Cretaceous or Tertiary sandstone and conglomerate underlie the Anit anomaly. Late Tertiary and Quaternary gravel and sand deposits cover the older sedimentary rocks.
