The Soil to Pan Philosophy is initiated from the pre-nursery stage. Palm seedlings imported from renowned producers of palm hybrid seeds are placed at the pre-nursery stage. BIDCO monitors the process rigorously, through to the nursery stage where all practices are in strict conformity with Best Agricultural Practices. BIDCO's conformity guarantees that procedures such as pruning and the eventual harvesting, lead to fruits with an abundance of oil. This in turn is moved to the factory where through a series of processes; high quality fats, oils and hygiene products are manufactured. These products find their way into institutions and homes.
