The 12,800 hectare farm is located in Mpongwe and produces soya, wheat and maize for the local Zambian market.

Presently, the farm has 2,600ha of land under irrigation. Chayton plans to develop a further 1,500ha of land under irrigation over the next three years. Somawhe Estates is an established and successful commercial farming operation and has been in operation in the region for several decades.

The acquisition is consistent with Chayton's strategy of expanding agricultural production within local markets in Sub-Sahara Africa. Presently, Chayton owns and manages roughly 4,000 irrigated hectares in production or development within Zambia.
