The company was established in 1995 and was first listed on the <u>London Stock Exchange</u> in 1997. In 2000 it commissioned the Morila mine and in 2005 commissioned the Loulo mine. [3]

The company's activities are concentrated on the following mines:

- Morila gold mine, Mali
- Loulo-Gounkoto mine complex, Mali
- Tongon Mine, Côte d'Ivoire
- Kibali Gold Mine, <u>Democratic Republic of Congo</u> (DRC)

Additional projects are Massawa in Senegal but exploration operations are predominantly undertaken in Mali and the Democratic Republic of Congo. Although registered in Saint Helier, Jersey, Mark Bristow, the CEO, operates mainly out of offices in London, England and the administrative functions are based in Johannesburg, South Africa. Bristow has urged caution about investing in South Africa while the present regime there remains in government.^[4]
