# Overview

"Jatropha hedges thrive on sandy loams in Binh Thuan. In 2010, Eco-Carbone, through its 67% equity share within a joint venture under constitution, will support the establishment of 100 ha of jatropha plantations after farmer trainings and the supply of quality jatropha seedlings free of cost. Moreover, Eco-Carbone will set up a processing unit in the Bac Binh district aiming to press around 50 tons of jatropha grains in 2010.
