Operating Permits for 10 Sugarcane Investors in Merauke Ends

Merauke, Jubi - Head of the Merauke Regency Investment Agency and Integrated Licensing Service, Sri Pramudyo Purnomo, said that ten sugarcane companies that have applied for permits for investment activities in this area have ended.

After applying for an investment license, however, the company does not carry out any activities their operating license has ended.

"I have written a letter to the Regent of Merauke, Frederikus Gebze, at the same time conveying that 10 companies have expired, even activities will not run at all. So it is proposed to be frozen and other investors to enter," said Purnomo to reporters Saturday (4/6/2016).





However, he continued, the final decision was up to the Merauke Regent. "Indeed, our proposal is that the company no longer needs to operate. Because all this time after taking care of the permit, there has been no activity at all in the field," he said.

The ten companies are PT Swarna Hijau Indah (Mayora Group), PT Dharma Agro Lestari (Astra Group), PT Karisma Agri Pratama, PT Agri Surya Agung (Modern Land group), PT Nusantara Agri Resources (Modern Land group), PT Anugrah Rejeki. Nusantara (Wilmar Group), PT Lestari Subur Indonesia (Wilmar group), PT Kurnia Alam Nusantara (Mayora Group), PT Randu Kuning Utama (Mayora Group) and PT Bhakti Agro Lestari (Astra Group)

A member of the Regional Representative Council (DPRRD) of Merauke Regency, Hengky Ndiken, who was asked to comment, said that if it is true that ten companies have never carried out their activities and their permits have ended, it should be decided.

"Yes, if they have been active, they may be reconsidered. But this clearly doesn't exist at all. I think what the Head of the Merauke Regency Investment Board said is very accurate. Where, existing companies do not need to operate," he said. (*)
