Ministry of Agriculture, Mozambique has assigned 9,875 hectares of land assigned to Montara Continental. The DUAT (Direito de Uso e Aproveitamento da Terra) provided by the government gives Montara the right to use the land for agricultural productivity.

- ✓ The land is situated within Namuno District, within a well-known ground-nut growing region
- ✓ Located only 280km from Pemba on good roads
- ✓ The project is well supported by district administration and local communities
- ✓ The farm is characterised as having a flat topography, with 16km of perennial river frontage running alongside the farm
- ✓ It has the potential for irrigation, so increasing productivity per hectare and local availability of food crops throughout the year

Our Namuno farm will initially grow oilseed crops such as groundnuts and sunflower, with other high value crops such as tomatoes and chillies being evaluated.

As with our other operations we are evaluating the development of a food processing facility for our Namuno operation and to support other future projects in the region. Once development is in progress we will look to work with local farmers in improving their productivity and to act as a conduit to new markets, ensuring neighbouring farms and local populations are key stakeholders in the project.
