Pungo Andongo: a strategic project for the nation

Recently, Odebrecht Angola established a presence in the agribusiness area. The company is taking part in an agroindustrial project on a 36,000-hectare farm in Pungo Andongo, in Malanje Province. The farm is owned by Gesterra-Land Management S.A., a state company associated with the Angolan Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development. This is a strategic reserve that the Angolan government is using to combat hunger and poverty. Odebrecht's role in the project includes managing agroindustrial production, building and operating maize flour and animal feed plants, and empowering people by developing a skilled workforce.
