Pos Indonesia Ready to Work on West Java Cargo Services

Majalengka, 23 February 2021. Cargo flights at Kertajati Airport officially operate on 23 February 2021. The inauguration of Kertajati Airport was carried out by the Governor of West Java Ridwan Kamil. The inauguration of Kertajati Airport Cargo was attended by the President Director of Garuda Indonesia, the President Director of Pos Indonesia, the President Director of Pos Logistik Indonesia, and several directors of cargo companies.

The inauguration of the Kertajati Airport Cargo was marked by the signing of a collaboration between the West Java Provincial Government and PT Garuda Indonesia. This cooperation commitment is expected to support the acceleration of economic growth in West Java and at the same time make Kertajati Airport a national logistics center.

The first cargo flight which marked the inauguration of the airport was carried out with the operation of flights to Batam. Pos Indonesia took advantage of this opportunity by sending one 1.5 tonne shipment of air cargo. The President Director of Pos Indonesia hopes that every Tuesday there will be regular flights from BIJB to Batam. Pos Indonesia will start working on logistics contracts in the agricultural sector and other potential cargo from West Java to Batam and other destination cities served from Kertajati airport.

The cargo service that was recently inaugurated at Kertajati Airport, Majalengka is targeted to be able to compete with airport cargo services in Jakarta. This was conveyed directly by the President Director of West Java International Airport (BIJB), Salahudin Rafi.

According to Rafi, BIJB is ready to welcome the presence of cargo services with the Boeing 737-800 airline Garuda Indonesia. Apart from having a 3,000 meter long runway, the available cargo terminal capacity also reaches 35 tons.

It will also prepare a cargo village which is targeted to be completed in the next one to two years.

"The capacity of the cargo terminal is 35 tons and the runway is 3,000, so there is no problem because it meets international standards. The cargo village is also being prepared, hopefully in 1-2 years it can be built," he said.

Meanwhile, the President Director of Garuda Indonesia, Irfaniaputera, added that currently the cargo service on the Kertajati - Batam route is capable of carrying up to 10 tons of West Java's superior commodities.
