Alhaji Aliko Dangote, Chairman of the Dangote Group has further expanded his investment profile in Africa with two projects-one each in sugar and cement-worth US\$1 billion in Senegal, according to Nigeria's PM News.

The investment makes Dangote the biggest wholly African investor ever in the Francophone country.

The company will also soon be starting work on its sugar factory in the country. The Senegalese government has allocated Dangote Industries about 40,000 hectares of land for the purpose. The cement project is providing hundreds of jobs for Senegalese and more jobs are expected when work on the sugar factory begins.
